At Wildflower Montessori, we believe there are benefits to both a Montessori and traditional approach to learning. We have taken a more modern approach to make sure our children are as prepared as they can possibly be.

HOW WE MAKE THIS HAPPEN

- ❖ The philosophy behind the Montessori approach is ever present in our school and all classrooms, the Grade School included.
- ❖ We educate the whole child and believe a child's social and emotional development is just as important as a child's cognitive development.
- ❖ We teach the children to recognize and cope with uncomfortable emotions, to problem solve and we promote peace education.
- We use traditional Common Core Standards for each grade level to make sure our children are where they need to be academically, but we also follow them if they are ready to move past "grade level."
- We use both Montessori manipulative materials as well as traditional workbooks and worksheets to bridge concepts from the concrete to the abstract.
- Most importantly, we follow the child! We believe in teaching to the individual child because that is what they are; individuals with unique needs, learning styles and gifts.
- This creates such a strong foundation and love of learning that the children will carry with them when they leave our school and beyond.
